

Upskilling in paediatric dysphagia: Ironically, there's no cookbook!

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BACKGROUND

- Many clinicians feel under-skilled in paediatric dysphagia management
- Challenging to provide professional development that meets different learning needs and workplace contexts

METHODS

- Online learning package developed and released internal to Q Health
- Pilot group of clinicians elected to participate in telesupervision clinic
 1. Pre-post surveys
 2. Semi-structured interviews with line managers

CONCLUSION

- Resources that support learners to direct their own supervision needs were helpful for **developing confidence** and had perceived **benefits to service delivery**

RESULTS

- >200 enrolments in online learning package
- 11 participants in telesupervision clinic (1-10+ years experience)
- At individual level, differences in confidence observed in areas targeted
- Themes from semi-structured interviews:
