

## Orthotist and Prosthetist Technician Learning Pathway Project

**The Problem:** Formal training in NSW for orthotist and prosthetist (OP) technicians does not exist. OP Technicians are a small but critical workforce.

**Needs analysis:** semi-structured interviews of all 12 NSW Health OP technicians and 4 Orthotists.

**Results:** high demand for a learning pathway. Required skill components identified.

## Benefits of NSW Health OP Learning Pathway:

- Sustainable training for the future for both new and experienced technicians.
- Structured approach to training.
- Utilises current workforce skills in training and assessment.
